TODAY'S THOUGHT: The nice thing about teamwork is that you always have others on your side. —Margaret Carty

Did you know there's power and energy in every step every person takes? In fact, each of us is a little power plant. Every step we take generates about six to eight watts of energy? But then — poof! — it dissipates into the air. That's why engineers are wondering whether there's a way to harness that energy.

Think about it. Every day about 300,000-500,000 people dash through Grand Central Station in New York City trying to catch their train during rush hours. We've got the power. If only we could capture it.

A firm in London is now looking at ways to capture that energy on a large scale and turn it into electricity by using vibration-harvesting sensors. These sensors would be implanted in the structure of train stations, bridges, factories, or any other building frequently rattled by commuters, vehicles or machinery. The devices could capture the rumblings of all this activity, turn them into electricity, and then store it in a battery. There's power in small steps!

This is a great reminder of the power of small things, little gestures, small steps. Don't think that the things you do every day don't have an impact on those around you. It all adds up!

If we take the "steps" we are able to take every day and do what the Lord has asked us to do, however large or small, God will provide the "energy" that brings a blessing to others — and ourselves.
