Sometimes you don't get to make the decision about a situation. Often your spouse makes the decision on what you are going to have for dinner, or sometimes your boss determines when you can take a vacation.

In the 22 years I spent in the U.S. Air Force I often had to move to places I didn't pick, because the Air Force made the choice for me. Once I was stationed in the Aleutian Islands for a year, which was far away from everything. But I also had some great assignments to places I didn't select, including the best one of my career.

As I mentioned in last month's OCC Newsletter, the South Eastern California Conference (SECC) is working on providing a successor to Pastor Ken. They do have a plan in place, and they briefed the OCC board on it in mid-February.

While it is a good plan, and should be a win for OCC, there is one condition we have to accept. And that is we don't get to decide who is Pastor Ken's replacement.

This is due to several factors. Ever since the pandemic, the tithe we collect at OCC has been

dropping. For 2023, we were about \$70,000 below the amount the SECC needs to receive from us each year. While that isn't the whole story or even the most important part, the conference also looks at membership growth and baptism numbers. Given this situation, there was the real possibility of the SECC putting OCC into a two church district, meaning we would have to share a pastor with another church.

The good news is that a two church district isn't going to happen. The conference has decided it needs to help us grow and be a better church with more support to our members, especially for our youth and children. So their choice for pastor is someone who has a passion for that.

We should be able to announce the name of our new pastor soon, but there are still a few logistical details to work out.

As the Apostle Paul says in Colossians: Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience.

Teddy Bear Sabbath—March 9
